accommodation needs with a successful pathway to private rental.

- To work with clients to gain independence in managing their tenancy, with gradually reduced supports
- To assist with rental inspections and tenancy issues
- To promote skills and create workshops relevant to independent living
- To assist young people to obtain longer term accommodation
- To participate in meetings, evaluation and quality assurance processes
- To adopt a trauma informed approach to working with young people
