TRAUMA RE-ENACTMENT

Traumatic re-enactment is a replaying of a past traumatic experience with people who are presently in a person's life.

There are often three roles: a victim, a persecutor and a rescuer.



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Group Think occurs when a group of people aims for harmony or conformity but this results in dysfunction as they try to reach a consensus without critical evaluation of alternative viewpoints.



Also known as secondary trauma, can be described as indirect exposure to a traumatic event through first-hand account or narrative of that event. The helper's beliefs about the world may be altered and/or damaged by repeated exposure.



Sanctuary is a trauma informed model which supports those who are working in stressful environments to apply mindful, safe and therapeutic practice to achieve positive growth and change in our communities.
