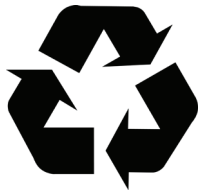


RECYCLE THE RIGHT WAY

WHAT GOES IN WHAT BINS



THE ONLY NUMBERS THAT ARE ABLE TO BE RECYCLED (ACT) ARE 1, 2, 3 AND 5. USE THE GARBAGE BIN FOR EVERYTHING ELSE (NUMBERS 4, 6 AND 7).



RECYCLING

THE RECYCLING BIN IS FOR EMPTY HOUSEHOLD CONTAINERS, PACKAGING, PAPER AND CARDBOARD ONLY.

Place these items in the recycle bin:

- Glass jars & bottles
- Aluminium cans, trays etc
- Most rigid plastic containers
- Paper, cartons & cardboard
- Steel cans, empty aerosols

Don't place these items in the recycle bin:

- Hazardous materials
- e-waste
- Building waste
- Garden waste
- Anything recyclable



LANDFILL

THE RUBBISH BIN IS FOR HOUSEHOLD/ OFFICE ITEMS THAT CANNOT BE RECYCLED.

Place these items in the rubbish bin:

- Sanitary items
- Broken toys
- Broken kitchenware
- polystyrene
- Broken kitchen ware

Don't place these items in the rubbish bin:

- Hazardous materials
- e-waste
- Building waste
- Garden waste
- Anything recyclable
