




Enjoy your **SANCTUARY CELEBRATION!**

Incorporating cultural elements such as an Acknowledgement of Country, especially if people are from an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander background, is a way to demonstrate inclusiveness. The event could even provide opportunity for cultural humility and learning as people may choose to share food, songs or artwork from different cultural backgrounds as part of the celebration.

our minds". See competition details on back




5 Host the funny hat competition & show CEO's video
