WHAT IS THE THREAD TOGETHER VAN?

The Thread Together van is a mobile wardrobe delivering brand new clothes and shoes to people in our community experiencing vulnerability.

We believe that we can help to restore hope and dignity to families who have experienced ongoing challenges by providing them the opportunity to select new quality outfits.

To date, the initiative has dressed more than 100,000 individuals nationally, supplying over \$8 million worth of clothing that would otherwise have ended up in landfill.

Our partner in this initiative, Thread Together, sources new end-of-season clothing from fashion retailers and redistributes to 120 charity partners nationally.

With the help of a stylist, customers can choose their own outfits to take home.

Our Thread Together mobile wardrobe is operated by volunteers who enable this service to run. Without volunteers, this vital service would not be possible.
