The Pantry Appeal seeks donations of non-perishable food and essential living items to support vulnerable families and individuals in the community who are in need of emergency food relief.

The items collected throughout the appeal are distributed to families and individuals in the community who are in need of emergency

assistance. Thanks to your generosity, in the past year we were able to collect over 100,000 items, as well as financial donations to directly help those in need.

The Pantry Appeal is supported by local schools, churches and businesses in addition to individual volunteers who run shopping centre stalls.

ITEMS TO BE COLLECTED:

The Pantry Appeal seeks donations of non-perishable items and toiletries. While we always need donations of soup, baked beans/spaghetti, and tinned beetroot, these items usually tend to be higher supply than the other items on the Pantry Appeal Shopping List.

Set up a collection point in your classroom or at your school.

Anglicare can send you collection tubs/ materials to place in a prominent position like a reception area or foyer.

Tell your students and other staff members about the Pantry Appeal.

Write about the Pantry Appeal in school's newsletter and promote at staff meetings and school assemblies.

3.

Share on Social Media.

By getting involved and contributing to our Pantry Appeal, you're making a real difference in the lives of vulnerable members of our community. Show your school community how you're getting behind this fantastic initiative by sharing it on social media.

4.

Keep us up to date.

Let Anglicare know about your collection so we can advise you of a food drop-off location, or arrange collection. We can even organise for one of our team to present briefly at a class or school assembly.
