HIPPY is a free two-year, play based curriculum of educational activity packs.

Starting when your child turns three, your HIPPY Tutor will pratice the activities with you during home visits.

Each pack has activities for you to do with your child and ideas so that learning can happen anywhere at any time.

HIPPY assists children to become curious learners and to achieve important development milestones.



HIPPY is supported by research that shows that children's most powerful learning comes from their family, and that getting a strong start at school sets children up for life.
